G. STANDARD OF CONDUCT

Southland Bible Institute recognizes that Christian freedom of conscience concerning areas of the Christian life are not always dealt with in Scripture. However, there is a greater recognition for creating an atmosphere which encourages the higher personal, moral, and spiritual growth expected of Christian servants. Some of our rules stem directly from Scripture, while some may come from a desire for greater spiritual discernment, and others by preference to those things necessary to create a God-honoring campus atmosphere.

In applying for admission, all candidates are required to sign this statement. The applicant will gladly adhere to the principles represented in the rules of the school. As a minimum requirement, the student is obligated:

- 1. To be a faithful student. He/she will utilize his time to the best possible advantage for academic success. This includes class attendance and study time.
- 2. To be included in Christian service. He/she will participate in spiritual activities and ministries while faithfully attending a local church.
- 3. To abstain from questionable practices such as the use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, illegal drugs, gambling, attendance at movies or dances, as well as watching TV programs, listening to radio, or reading literature which are contrary to the standards of God's Word.
- 4. To avoid every form of immorality, whether sexual or social, such as lying, stealing, cheating, or failing to meet financial obligations promptly.
- 5. To dress modestly, decently, and neatly, seeking to glorify God by a positive physical appearance to maintain a good testimony in the community.

Students, by virtue of enrollment, agree to live within the guidelines presented here. While some may not have personal convictions in accord with these standards, enrolling in school obligates the student to assume responsibility for adherence to them. Any behavior, either on campus or away, which indicates that a student has disregard for the spirit of the school standards is sufficient reason for dismissal.
