In the month of July 1945, I became very curious about a white bus passing through our town every evening about the same hour. I would stand on the sidewalk and listen to the voices of the people singing as the bus would pass. I knew that those people had something that I didn't have and something that I wanted. That something was joy and peace.

One day I received an invitation to attend church, with the assurance of a good time. I accepted the invitation, and in the church that night I took Christ as my Savior.

The following month was camp week for the church, and I attended camp. At the last evening of camp, I dedicated my life to be used in the service of Christ my Savior. I said, "Lord, I'll go where you want me to go," and I started praying that the Lord would

show me if He wanted me in His service. One day a very godly man came to me and told me that he would like to aid me in my Christian life by sending me to **Bible school**. I knew then that God had answered my prayer, and so I accepted his proposition and was directed to **Southland Bible Institute**.
